Make Complete button be red same as iPhone forcing the work order signoff page.


## **Analysis:**

The request pertains to a feature present in the ECOBPM mobile application but absent in SWEVEN.


This feature involves displaying the "complete work order" button in red and requesting the technician's signature along with additional data. This data includes the technician's full name, materials used, travel details, comments, and hours worked. These details are then added to the work order as a note, with the signature being collected in a dedicated section.



## Implementation of Signature Request in SWEVEN:

To incorporate this feature, a new section must be added to the settings of SWEVEN. This section will allow users to toggle the signature request feature on or off. When enabled, users should be able to specify when the technician's signature is required (sub status).

Additionally, modifications are needed in the API that guides mobile device actions. This includes adding a label within the configured sub status to indicate the need for a signature. This ensures that the mobile device knows when to prompt for a signature.

Furthermore, an API needs to be developed to handle the reception of signatures and additional data. This API will also be responsible for creating a note and appending the collected signature.

Finally, adjustments must be made to the mobile application itself. These modifications will allow the application to utilize the defined settings and prompt for a signature when necessary. The application should also possess the capability to transmit the signature and accompanying data.

Lastly, the work order format must be updated to accommodate the display of added signatures.

### Signature Required

To determine whether the signature is required, you can access the API settings under the "features" section. The "signatureRequired" option is a boolean field that indicates whether the signature is necessary or not.

### Signature Store

To store the signature, simply include a note with additional parameters, setting "signature" to true and "completed" to true as well. It's important to note that the signature fields should be added as a message within the note.
